# Hayya 'Alal Falah

#### Salah is a Feast

It is from the Special Rahmah and Ihsan of Allah that He has invited His servants to a feast through Salah comprising of various kinds of delicacies, nourishments, gifts and grants. He has honored and dignified His servants by inviting them five times a day.

- There are two benefits and blessings which the servant receives while performing Salah, which is not available through any other means of worship.
- Salah is not only a means of expiation from sins but also a means of light and spiritual nourishment that which gives strength through which leaving sins become easier.
- Salah prevents from immodesty and enhances personal growth, the person comes in the protection of Allah Jundub bin Abdullah in narrates, Prophet is said, "Whoever prays Fajr comes under the responsibility of Allah". (Sahih Muslim: 1439)
- Salah increases the share of one's provision, gives relief from fear and sorrow, navigates in trials and gives cure from illness. Allama Ibn al Qayyim says, "Many a person has been cured from illnesses through Zikr of Allah and leaping towards the Salah.
- Allah honors the one who is present for Salah, gives rewards for each step and raises his rank.
- Preparations are made for him in Jannah, thus the person returns from Salah as if Allah has quenched his thirst. Before his heart was deprived of rain and was experiencing drought, thirst, hunger and nakedness. After performing Salah Allah returns him with riches through gifts which make the servant unconcerned of his needs being fulfilled through others, sins are forgiven, he becomes fresh and vigorous and returns with the duas of Angels.



#### Hajj Training via Workshops

Alhamdulillah this year also Hajj trainings were conducted via workshops. Through these workshops participants were taught how to perform hajj in accordance with Sunnah. Hajj literature of Al-Huda Publication was also distributed.

Multan: Workshops conducted under the Regional Office were attended by 45 women and 35 men. Apart from this, a camp was set in Qila Qasim Bagh, in which Hajj issues related to women were discussed. Food arrangements were done for haji's coming from other cities and literature and cards helpful in facilitating the hajj were also distributed.

Islamabad: In Al-Huda Islamabad 70 staff members from Rawalpindi, Jehlum, Abbotabad, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Gojarkhan, Chakwal, Juwailiyan, Bahawalpur, Gujrat and Haripur were given training to spread awareness among people in their areas. Apart from this, weekly workshops were also conducted.

Peshawar: Under the regional office, 2,000 'Hajj e Baitullah' booklet and 1,000 'Hajj guide' cards were distributed at the airport.

Sindh: Under Karachi Regional Office, like the previous year's hajj workshops and hajj camps were conducted in various branches. This year workshops were conducted in Shikarpur, Ladkana, Meerpurkhas, Sukhar and Madiji for the first time, which were attended by around 350 people. People of these regions appreciated these workshops and expressed their enthusiasm for more such workshops.

#### Hayya 'Alal Falah Course

In Al-Huda Canada, Dr. Farhat Hashmi highlighted the spiritual side of Salah by conducting a course in Salah from the Book "As Salah min kalam Ibn al *Qayyim*" from 14<sup>th</sup> July to 19<sup>th</sup> August. Apart from Al-Huda Staff and Students, a large audience benefitted from this course via online facility.

Al-Huda Karachi DHA camp completed its 10<sup>th</sup> Batch of Miftah al Qur'an course. 150 students completed this course. In this course they were taught basic Qaida, Juz 30<sup>th</sup>, Masnun Duas, Azkar and how to pray. Certificates were also distributed to the students.

#### **Effectual workshops under ATEC**

In order to enhance educational skills for the teachers and other members of AIS, 14 workshops on varied topics were conducted by Training and Education Centre Islamabad. Staff and members from Islamabad, Karachi, Peshawar and Faisalabad participated in these workshops. Certificates were distributed to the participants.

#### Food Stall

In Al-Huda Islamabad, students of weekly Taleem ul Qur'an course made arrangements for food stall. Staff and students prepared home cooked delicacies and drinks. The main purpose of this campaign apart from highlighting the importance of spending in the cause of Allah was also to show how charity can be given even with meager means through intelligent planning. Funds which were accumulated through food stall were donated for Al-Huda building.





# **Services to Humanity**

#### Supply of water

Under the supervision of Al-Huda, it's Social Welfare Division dug wells in remote areas for the under privileged communities. Apart from wells, hand pumps and filtration plants were also installed. In the last four months Hand Pumps were installed in the areas of Rawalpindi and Multan.

#### Construction of Masjid in Tharparkar (Badin)

Alhamdulillah Masjid construction in Tharpakar has been completed. Under the supervision of Al-Huda Karachi Branch arrangements were made for Taraweeh and Iftari in this Masjid. People enthusiastically came to attend. More such efforts are needed in the remote areas of Sindh.



Uthman bin Affan in narrated that: He heard Allah's Messenger say: "Whoever builds a Masjid for (the sake of) Allah, then Allah will build a similar house for him in Paradise." [Sunan Tirmidhi:318]

#### Ramadan ration and Iftar programs

Like previous years, this year also prior to Ramadan Al-Huda made arrangements to provide ration for the needy far and wide across the country. About 9,198 packages comprising of basic commodities were distributed in Punjab, Kashmir, Sindh, Khyber Pakhtunkhaw and Baluchistan. Apart from distributing ration, Iftar arrangements were made for areas in Karachi, Lahore, Multan, Raheem Yar Khan, Gojar Nawala, Wah Cantt, Meerpur and other regions. Large number of people benefitted from these campaigns.






## **Student Corner**

Once she saw a homeless old woman crying in front of Edhi Center so she took her home and let her stay wit her for some months. She would greatly respect her teachers and would attend the lectures of Respected Dr. Farhat Hashmi enthusiastically. In spite of her personal issues and deteriorating health, she had good assumption with Allah and was very cheerful person who treated people with sincerity. Our dear sister's face was looking fresh and serene after she was given her final bath.
